Parents, please read the following Code of Conduct/Cast Member Contract with your child. Please have your student bring signed copies of the Code of Conduct/Cast Member Contract to Auditions or to the Parent Meeting.

As a member of a Superstar Productions show, I know that I am an important part of the Superstar team. Being a strong team member means having responsibilities. I promise to abide by the Superstar Code of Conduct, as follows:

- 1. I will do my best to have a positive attitude and be a team player.
- 2. I understand that it is a privilege to be part of this program and to use the rehearsal and performance spaces. I promise to treat all rehearsal and performance spaces with respect.
- **3.** I will attend all rehearsals and performances for which I am scheduled. I am aware that if I miss more than three rehearsals for reasons other than illness or emergency, my part may be reassigned to another actor.
 - (a) I am aware that during tech week (the week leading up to performances) I will have rehearsals every day.
- 4. I will be prepared for all rehearsals by:
 - (a) Reading the entire script to a parent or other adult before the first rehearsal.
 - **(b)** Memorizing my lines, songs, and scene changes at home by the required date.
 - **(c)** Coming prepared for rehearsal with these items:
 - My script
 - A nut-free snack that I can eat in 5 minutes
 - A water bottle
 - Pencils
 - Sneakers or dance shoes (Please no boots or sandals)
- 5. I promise to treat others with respect.
 - (a) I will pay attention to, look at, and listen to the Instructor and all other staff members.
 - (b) I will treat other cast members the way I wish to be treated: as an important member of the Superstar team whose talents and contributions to the show are valuable and worthy of respect.
 - (c) I am aware that Superstar Productions has a zero-tolerance policy for bullying. I understand that bullying is grounds for immediate dismissal from the production. Bullying includes but is not limited to:
 - Name-calling
 - Teasing
 - Excluding
 - Verbal or physical abuse
 - 6. I promise to respect the costumes and props and the work that went into making them.
