REHEARSAL ATTENDANCE

- We have a short rehearsal process and attendance is very important for all actors. When an actor is missing from rehearsal it affects the whole cast.

 - O Tech week is when the actors work with the set, as well as with costumes, lights, and microphones.

PICKUP

Please arrive 5 minutes before the end of rehearsal and wait outside the gym/theater for the children to be dismissed. Before you leave the building, you must sign out your child and any children in your car pool. Please make arrangements with another parent to be your child's back-up transportation in the event that you are late.

Late pick-ups will result in a late fee of \$1 per minute, immediately payable to the instructor.
